They studied the medicinal values of Adhatoda Plant in bacterial, fungal and viral infection. It has been published in the International Journal of all Pharmaceutical Sciences & Research volume 15, issue 8, Jan 2024 impact factor 7.429



Our RDC member Dr. Munish Kumar Associate Professor, Department of Science performed research work on "Bulgarian chemical communications". He has studied the intermolecular interaction between binary liquid mixture of dihydro mycenol that can be used by aroma in many industrial products.
